

Shut down the tractor and remove the key before repairing, servicing, lubricating or cleaning the machine.

Relieve all hydraulic pressure in the hoses. Disconnect the hydraulic hoses from the tractor before going near the machine.

Securely block the machine to avoid any movement while doing the work.





Do Not Enter Tub While Parts Are Rotating

Before entering the tub:

- Turn off the tractor and remove the key.
- Wait for rotating parts to stop


Contact with the rotating flail drum will cause serious injury or death.

### **Installing On The Right Tub Wall**

- 1. Remove the fasteners (1) that connect the top of the front screen to the right tub wall.
  - Keep these fasteners as they will be used later.



#### Installation of the Bale Top Deflectors

- 2. Place the deflector panel into the wall tubes.
  - Ensure the bent portion of the panel is toward the inside of the tub.
- 3. Fasten the front of the deflector.
  - Use the fasteners that were removed in Step 1.
  - Place the fastener through the screen and wall tube.
- 4. Fasten the rear of the deflector with the supplied ½" x 2 ½" bolt and locknut.

## Installing On The Left Tub Wall

- 1. Remove the fasteners (1) that connect the top of the front screen to the left tub wall.
  - Keep these fasteners as they will be used later.
- 2. Place the deflector panel into the wall tubes.
  - Ensure the bent portion of the panel is toward the inside of the tub.




- Use the fasteners that were removed in Step 1.

### **Installing On The Front Right Tub Wall**




- 5. Place the camera between the screen tube and front tube.

Note: If a top deflector is being installed on the rear tub wall, leave the spacer and fasteners until the rear deflector is installed.

### Installing On The Rear Right Tub Wall

- 1. Remove the fasteners and spacer tube between the front and rear wall.
  - Note: If the front deflector is being installed, these fasteners will have already been removed.
  - Keep these fasteners and spacer as they will be used later.





- 2. Place the deflector panel into the wall tubes.










Fasten Rear of the Deflector
